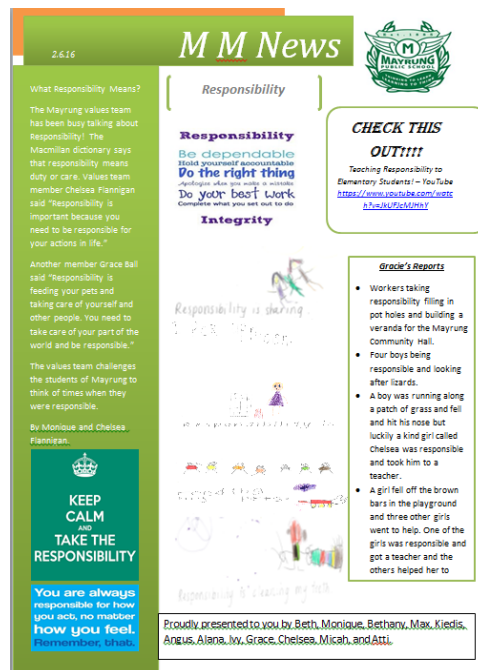
3 children \$135).
